Top 4 Safety Points

- •Read and understand Safe Operating Procedure
- •Only load and unloading whilst trailer is attached to vehicle
- Do not drive with the platform elevated on sloping or uneven ground above 4 degrees and avoid driving on lesser slopes
- •Beware of uneven ground and power lines



General Safety Instructions

- •Complete pre-start checklist
- •Read Manufacturers Operation Manual (www.flexihire.com.au)
- •Report any faults or damage to Flexihire 1300FLEXIHIRE
- •Do not wear loose clothing or jewellery
- •Do not operate equipment near pedestrians or people
- •Do not operate without the appropriate PPE as detailed
- •Do not operate equipment under the influence of drugs or alcohol

General Engine Safety

- •Refuelling Do not smoke, or introduce ignition source, always turn engine off and allow engine to cool first, relieve fuel pressure by loosening cap slowly, wipe clean any fuel spills prior to re-start, If fuel spilled on clothes change clothes, ensure cap is replaced & store fuel vessel away from work area
- •Do not breathe fuel vapour& replace cap securely after fuelling
- •Do not operate engine without adequate ventilation
- •Beware of hot surfaces on engine & other parts

Risk Assessment

- •Assess the immediate work area for any hazards
- •Control or eliminate all the risks associated with the hazards
- Hazards to check for that may require risk control-

 □ Overhead power lines
 □ Working at height

 □ Digging
 □ Falling objects

 □ Confined space
 □ High Voltage

 □ Traffic & moving machinery
 □ Any stored energy

☐ Stored energy – air, hydraulic, electricity, pressure

Operating Safety Instructions

General Electricity Safety

- •Ensure all electrical equipment has a current test tag within 3 months
- •Do not operate equipment in or around water or damp environments
- •It is recommended to use a safety switch to power this equipment
- Ensure the power lead is well stowed and do not present trip hazards
- •Isolate the power by removing the plug prior to performing any work on the equipment including prior to changing leads or tools or bits
- •Always uncoil power leads prior to use

Ensure operators of EWP's with a platform height of 11m or greater Always perform the pre-start functions in the EWP Log Book and hold a WP - National Licence to Perform High Risk Class WP. For all ensure that the safety release is operable from the gr other EWP's it is recommended to have a Yellow card or similar competence training Ensure the EWP has a log book on hand and check that it is in service Use barricades to restrict pedestrian and traffic flow near the EWP and has no current service faults. Never use if the EWP has a fault Check overhead hazards including powerlines and maintain Do not tie the EWP platform to an adjacent platform or structure minimum approach distances from all powerlines – see manual Check the ground where the EWP will be operated to ensure it is Do not use the EWP lift as a lifting aid, crane or lifting or device. Do firm dry and free from obstructions and holes. Electric scissors not use the boom to push or pull objects should operate on sealed surfaces Plan the work to be done Do not allow anyone to tamper with the machine from the ground whilst in use unless under emergency conditions Check the SWL (Safe Working Load) of the EWP and ensure the Ensure all gates on the basket remain closed at all times unless weight to be placed in the basket including the personnel is under entering and exiting the basket from the ground the SWL Do not drive with the platform elevated on sloping or uneven Keep both feet or all persons in the basket firmly on floor at all ground above 4 degrees and avoid driving on lesser slopes times. Do not stand on ladders, boxes or the basket Check the load limit of bridges and ramps before driving on them Do not use the machine as a ground for welding If the boom is in a position with one or more wheels off the ground, Do not operate the machine in wind conditions or with wind gusts remove all personnel before attempting to stabilize equal or greater than 40KMPH Use spotters and look out personnel when vision is obscured Stow EWP, lower and park on flat level ground and shut down all power before leaving EWP. Never use anything other than operators foot to engage the safety Travel grades in slow speed only and beware of stopping distances in foot switch all speeds, switch to slow speed before stopping Refer to manual for lifting instructions but never lift with only 2 Refer to manual for towing instructions chains or slings. If EWP is on a trailer, ensure trailer is attached to vehicle when loading and unloading
