Coming into contact with moving parts

- Take care that the shoe hits parallel to the ground.
- Never work on hard surfaces such as rock, concrete etc.

Manual Handling Hazard

- Use the central lifting point for mechanical lift.
- Use the front roller provided on the frame when moving short distances.

Coming into contact with hot engine parts

- The muffler is fitted with a hearcheild and the engine is protected by a frame.
- Warning "Hot Surface" decals on plant.

Inhaling exhaust or fuel fumes

- Only operate in a well ventilated area

Explosion or fire from fuel

- Stop the engine before refuelling.
- Replace tank cap after refuelling.

Hearing damage from excessive noise

- hearing protection must be worn. Warning decal on plant

Key Operating Instructions

Please refer to the Operation & Maintenance manual SLT600-1EN

Fill the fuel tank with unleaded fuel

Check the engine oil

Put the throttle in the start position

Put fuel tap to ON position

Put switch on engine to ON position

Choke (always use choke unless the engine is warm)

Prime the carburetor using the pump (Press 5-6 Times)

Start the engine by pulling the recoil rope.

Turn off the choke

Move the throttle to the full rev operating position. If the engine is cold please do this slowly to avoid stopping the engine, and the rammer will now operate

To stop simply put the throttle in idle position.

Put switch on engine to OFF position

Turn fuel tap to off position
